

The car show at Rookies was the first car show and we were proud to announce that Dane's truck was chosen as "Rookies Choice". Dane served close to two-years in the US Army. He left in September 2017 for basic training at Fort Benning, GA. After graduating basic training and AIT as a 15 Tango (Blackhawk repairer) he was stationed at Fort Wainwright, Alaska where he served until he was honorably and medically discharged in 2019. We are so grateful to Dane's family for bringing his truck to the show and sharing his story with us.
