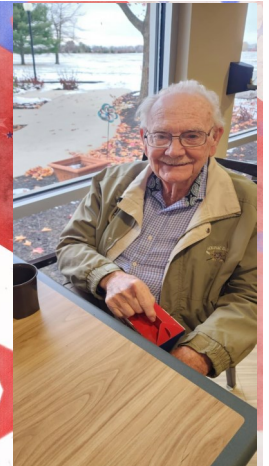

shipping labels so we didn't have to go through the hassle of creating them.

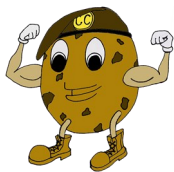

Butterscotch Chip Cookie, which was also absolutely enjoyed.

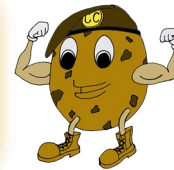
Attached, you'll find some pictures from a few of our offices, showcasing our team

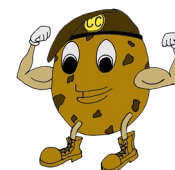
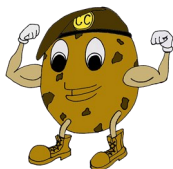




Patriot Plaza Mural
